

## Day 1-3: The Banff Lodge, Bulawayo

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### Matopos National Park

The Matopos National Park contain some of the most majestic scenery in the world. The landscape has been sculpted out of millions of years of weathering resulting in great "Whaleback" Domes and castle-like formations. It is a place of ancestral spiritual significance, and has served as both a shrine and refuge through the centuries.

These hills have the largest concentration of Raptors (birds of prey) in the world in particular the majestic Black Eagle. The Matopos National Park that we visit encompasses the grave of Cecil John Rhodes and many fine examples of ancient rock paintings left by the San (Bushmen) People.

It is home to the endangered Black and White Rhinoceros, now closely guarded in an intensive conservation program, and the magnificent Sable antelope. Visitors have the opportunity not only to drive through the scenery but also the chance to horse back or walk among the hills with an experienced and knowledgeable guide.
